Lynn released her first CD, *Texas Bound!*, in 2000. She became a full time musician in 2007, in concert with a move to the truly inspiring environs of Jackson Hole WY and Zion Canyon UT. She released her second CD, *Love and Loss*, featuring 14 original songs and 10 guest musicians, in May of 2009.

Currently living in Ohio, where she is preparing her parents' home for sale, Lynn has begun playing mandolin and ukulele in addition to guitar and light percussion.
